## Medeco Security Focus:

### *Borough of Manhattan Community College*

Russell Halloran, institutional locksmith for the Borough of Manhattan Community College in New York, is responsible for the total security of the college. As Russell puts it, "if it can be locked, I'm responsible for it."

Currently Russell's responsibility includes the security of 1,800 doors and the distribution and tracking of 7,500 keys.

#### *Security Challenge*

The Borough of Manhattan Community College opened in 1982 using Corbin-Russwin System 70. As the college expanded and enrollment increased, it became clear that a high security system was needed.

With 7,000 keys in circulation it was imperative that unauthorized access to buildings, classrooms, labs, computer rooms, and the HAZMAT area was controlled.

"Our security challenge was to find a company that could offer high security

solutions," recalls Russell. "Installing locks on doors and issuing keys wasn't providing the security we needed. In fact, it was creating more security problems. Keys were being duplicated without authorization and there was property loss due to picked locks. What we needed was an overall security solution that would help the college regain control."
